Trustee Lemme

a. Street Sign Reimbursement Program

Village Trustee Lemme attended some HOA meetings last month. A question for consideration for the Village to reimburse the HOA the cost of a standard Village provided street sign when the HOA is installing custom signage for the neighborhood. Discussion of other HOA's who have installed custom signs, should the Village go back to HOA's and reimburse for standard Village signs. Discussion of maintenance of the custom signage. Discussion of a Village uniform standard sign throughout the Village like many other Villages in our area and would show the Deer Park streets. Discussion of neighborhoods without an HOA and why they don't have custom signage. Discussion of the permitting and the bond which should be paid by the HOA. All Permits are subject to FOIA. The HOA's are responsible for the replacement of a custom sign. If the HOA doesn't replace the sign, it will be removed and replaced with a Village standard street sign. After discussion the Village Administrator will summarize and discussion will resume at July's COW.

Village Administrator McAndrews

a. Rectangular Rapid Flashing Beacon (RRFB) at Long Grove Rd and Laurel Drive

Village Administrator McAndrews provided the Committee an update for the RRFB on Long Grove Road. Question to continue the project or not. Due to the elevation issues, installation of sidewalks for the crosswalk and a traffic study the cost is over budget. Discussion of returning the beacon would have a restocking fee. Discussion of keeping the beacon and install it later. Discussion of requesting to lower the speed limit on Long Grove

Road. Discussion of the Sheriff monitoring traffic. Discussion once the light is complete at Ela and Long Grove the traffic will increase.




