a. Chapter 115 Peddlers and Solicitors

Discussion of Village Municipal Code, Chapter 115 Peddlers and Solicitors. Currently, the Village of Deer Park doesn't require solicitors to obtain a permit issued by the Village. In a past newsletter the Village offered a "No Solicitors" sign for resident's front door. This sign tells solicitors are not allowed to knock on resident's doors, except for Minors under the age of 18 who solicit for fundraising activities; e.g. Girl Scouts, Boy Scouts, students selling high school-sponsored items, Politicians, candidates and religious groups. Other Villages in the area require, special vests, background checks, Village provided ID cards with picture, and sends pictures to all residents, require a deposit for the Vest (refundable) and a fee to process the permit. Discussion of options for the Village to edit the Village code to require permits. Discussion of what would be required for a Door-to-Door solicitor and how the Village would change the Municipal code. Direction to staff to provide more details at next Committee of the Whole Meeting.
